- The following rules and policies will be followed at all times while being in this class and/or while under Mr. Hessel's supervision.
- Do what is asked of you by Mr. Hessel or any adult in the classroom at all times. TRY and use common sense whenever possible. Do what is asked and expected of you and everything will be just groovy.
- Be on time for class! If you are not in your SEAT when the bell rings you will be counted as tardy. Diving into the room or wandering about the room without direction as the bell rings is not being in your seat. Three tardies equals (=) some quality time before or after school.
- Be prepared for class. You will be expected to use writing utensils and paper in this class. Bring whatever technology or technical device you need for class to be successful. That said, make me a happy camper and bring paper and something to write with everyday to class.
- Food or food-like products are not allowed in the computer lab. Any evidence of you having food in the computer lab will result in daily point deductions. Excessive abuse of this rule will result in quality time before or after school. Example: If I have to ask you to put food (hamburger) or food-like products (chips, snacks) away you will be awarded special quality time before or after school. Water or juice is allowed in the lab provided it has some type of screw top lid to it, and that you bring it in before class. Do not ask to go and purchase these items during class time unless you like hearing the word "no." ☺
- "Creating" ways out of class: You have passes for restroom and water intake use. Use them wisely. I tend to not enjoy being interrupted while lecturing or doing class activities.
- Techiquette: Practice this in class at all times. Most discipline problems in this classroom are avoided if you practice this. Social Etiquette: If someone is talking to you, you should put your device down and pay attention to them. We will discuss this in class at length.
- Phones/Music Stuff: As per handbook policy, cell phones or any other electronic device are NOT to be used in class unless you have permission from Mr. Hessel AND it is for educational use. Violations Policy is first offense = device detained for the class period, second offense = device detained for the duration of school day, third offense = device will be detained until parent retrieves device. Points will be deducted from your grade if you demonstrate a consistent misuse of these technologies in class. See Phone Jail.
- Phones, iPods, or thumb drives are not to be plugged into school computers without permission. See "Toy" rule above.

- Late work: As per school policy, you will be given one day plus the number of days gone from school to turn in any late work. I will not track you down when you are gone, so do the right thing and gather your assignments from me as soon as possible. All assignments are posted a week ahead of time in the computer lab, and normally you will receive your assignments for the week thru school email.
- Do not download software or bring software to school for use on these computers. This is done to help keep the virus gang from plaguing our happy little computer lab. This is a very serious issue, so please help keep the lab virus free!
- The Internet: Ask permission prior to getting on the Internet. I will rarely deny your request to use the Internet, but I need to know who is on and where you are traveling on the old Information Superhighway. Playing games online, chatting with others, or other things that don't deal with school will not be allowed during class time.
- Don't try and drive a car with a cougar in it. What movie is this from? (Just seeing if you are really reading this!)
- Class Points: When applicable daily class points will be awarded to students who are complying with class rules, show up on time for class, and doing the required class work on that day. This has been put in place to help students earn points for themselves that may need that little edge at semester time. Students who are tardy or who miss class time because of discipline related issues will not receive class points on that day.
- Any rules not covered above will be handled on an as needed basis. All rules covered in the RHS handbook will also be enforced.
- Detentions: Yes I award these on occasion and NO your experience in detention will not be a pleasant one if you make me come to school early. ☺
